

The Classic .45 ACP Bullseye Load

Allan Jones, who wrote the Speer Number 12 reloading manual, says the classic Bullseye .45 ACP load is a 185-grain bullet and Bullseye powder loaded to about 800 fps.

“A lot of shooters like our 185-grain TMJ (Total Metal Jacket) Match bullet. It feeds well, is very accurate, doesn't lead the barrel and for indoor shooters it keeps the airborne lead to a minimum.”

This bullet is electronically plated with jacket material to completely cover the bullet. This precise process of adding jacket material one molecule at a time creates a very accurate bullet with no jacket edges to deform and destroy accuracy as in traditional hard ball bullets. Also, there is no exposed lead at the base to vaporize and add to air contaminants, something important to indoor ranges.
