

Safety Tip

There's no good reason to fear annealing. It's easy enough and safe enough for anyone who's willing to be reasonably careful doing it. But experience and observation have shown that you must do one thing:

Don't have powder, primers, ammo, lighter fluid, gasoline, or the like anywhere near.

Murphy's Law is right, as far as it goes. But Murphy was a pollyanna. Howell's Law is more realistic: Whatever can't possibly go wrong will go wrong sooner or later. Don't make matters worse by being careless.
