Tools You Need

The tools required to complete the Caspian Race Ready kit are items normally found in a well-equipped home workshop. The gunsmithing tools required were a chamber reamer and its appropriate holder and perhaps a small square ceramic stone for the hammer and sear work. The following list of tools were used to assemble the Caspian kit.

- A flat, mill bastard file
- Triangular files (2), small and medium size
- $\frac{3}{16}$ -inch round file
- Dremel tool with $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch carbide burr, $\frac{1}{8}$ -inch carbide oval burr, and $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch fine drum sander.
- Cratex abrasive drums, coarse to fine
- Flat, hard Arkansas stone
- Small square ceramic stone

- Interchangeable bit screwdriver set
- Pin punches, $\frac{1}{8}$ inch and $\frac{1}{16}$ inch
- 400-grit emery paper
- 400-grit lapping compound
- Synthetic or brass hammer
- Brass or aluminum drift
- Dial caliper
- Acetone
- Indelible marker, black or blue
- .45 ACP chamber reamer and holder
