

# Scope Choice

Our choice of scope has always been the Burris fixed-power, 7X EER without parallax adjustment. For a reticle, it has a 1 minute-of-angle dot at the intersection of fine crosshairs. It has been dependable, even after years of airline and road travel and the continual pounding of recoil. It also provides a high level of optical definition with a minimum of weight and complexity. This scope also optimizes the eye relief on the Glenn XP-100 to allow comfortable positioning of the head and neck in both offhand and prone positions.

It also has a tall target turret for vertical adjustments and the regular turret for lateral adjustments. We chose this unusual pairing so that when the gun is packed on its side in a case, the lateral (shorter) adjustment turret would be less likely to be damaged or compressed by rough handling.
