Stoppages with our three test ammunition brands make us leery of recommending this one for tactical use.

Though we tested for the harsh conditions of tactical use, these shotguns would serve just as well as self-defense tools. Civilians would appreciate the large capacity and robustness of these guns, we think.



The shooter can vary the precision of the ghost ring sight alignment by moving forward and backward on the stock. But we'd have preferred a more rearward position of the rear sight—with more air, as shown—for fast target acquisition.



Here's what ended it for the FN. We experienced stoppages with all three of our test ammos, and finally gave up on the gun. In the so-called "tactical" world, the shooter can't have tools that don't work, and this gun didn't work for our team.
