The Buck Mark was a good-looking pistol with comfortable if large grips. There are at least two dozen versions of this gun available, all of 'em with excellent adjustable sights. This gun had a good but heavy trigger, looked and worked great, but didn't have the accuracy of the Ruger. It cost a bit more, too.

The Buck Mark had an excellent adjustable rear sight with good-size screws for windage and elevation. The big Allenhead screw behind the rear sight is part of the takedown. You have to unbolt the barrel from the frame to get at the insides. Note the protrusions on the slide for cocking.

The rear-most lever is the safety, shown in the firing position. It struck our thumb there. The safety pivots at the front. The slide-lock was easy to operate for right-handed shooters.
