There's no accounting for taste, of course, but we found the Browning's wood figure and aggressive pistol grip with a palm swell to be eye catching.

We can't say it makes a great deal of sense, but at least it stayed out of our way. The X-Bolt's short-throw bolt made scope mounting easy and gave us generous operating clearance with gloved hands.
