Sig Sauer P250 9mm, \$749

GUN TESTS GRADE: A-

Putting aside the versatility of its modular design and focusing solely on how our test pistol performed, we thought the precision of its DAO trigger nearly redefines the concept. The major negative we found was muzzle flip hurt the gun's ability to be fired quickly.



Glock G17 9mm, \$599

GUN TESTS GRADE: A-

We think the G17 might be Glock's best all-round pistol. It's still a bit boxy in the hand, but it is very accurate, simple, and economically priced.



Heckler & Koch P2000 LEM

Variant 2 9mm, \$879

GUN TESTS GRADE: B+

The more we shot this gun, the more we liked it. We think anyone will be able to shoot the LEM trigger for accuracy, but learning to shoot it quickly will take practice.
