Both the P2000 LEM and the P250 began with long trigger pulls. But the Sig Sauer trigger swept all the way to the break with little change in resistance. The distance of the pull was the same every time, and the trigger had to be fully released before it would reset. This did not stop us from being able to fire it quickly.
