**Above:** The cosmetics on the Chiappa were stunning. Deep, rich casehardened color on the receiver and lever were matched in tone, and the metalwork was smooth and the joints tight. **Right:** This gun was made of steel, which made it heavy. That wasn't all bad, however, because heavier loads would have punished the sloppy-mount shooter.



**Above:** There's lots of pitch in that buttstock—the relationship between the angle of the buttplate and the boreline defines how the shooter has to mount the gun. **Upside:** The large amount of pitch makes for a comfortable head position on the gun, and it comes up level and fast. **Right:** Here's something you'll need to change if you buy the Chiappa. The steel buttplate looks great, but it punishes the shooter. Active CAS participants will need a gel replacement, which changes the looks.
