The Mossberg 590A1's thin, hollowed-out rubber slipon pad did very little to attenuate harsh recoil. The Mossberg kicked the shoulder and caused hand-slap from its tactical pistol grip. Our hand and fingers were left stinging after just a few shots with 1½-ounce 1200-fps loads.



Due to the skeletonized shell carrier of the Mossberg 590A1, effortless loading with no snags is easy from the bottom without a flap to push out of the way, as in the 870 platform.
