Lowered and flared ejection ports are a popular modification, especially on competition pistols. But we thought the degree of relief on the Solo's ejection port was remarkable. Note the scalloping front and rear of the port. Must have worked, since we had no malfunctions.



One component that ensured reliable cycling was the Solo's low-mass barrel. It was able to move quickly in and out of battery. Another was the two-piece recoil/guide rod.



The Kimber Solo's striker and striker spring was backed by a heavy plate (arrow), and there was a stop located at the base of the breechface. We noticed a surprising number of roll pins throughout the Solo, and saw where one partially backed out.
