Left: Push the button at the back of the receiver (arrow) and the stock folds over the left side of the receiver, as shown at right. The rifle can be transported or fired with the stock locked closed.

Push the button protruding from the buttplate and the folded stock releases back out to full length. The button bugged us during normal firing.





The pistol grip was checkered and offered a good grip on the Arsenal, but we thought it was too thin. Above and to the right of the grip is the rotating sling swivel, which allowed the shooter to carry the gun comfortably.
