The fully adjustable rear sight had an aluminum body and could be easily mounted or removed. But together with the front sight, we didn't feel this was a truly precision unit.

We felt that the tall stanchion of the M16-style front sight (center) was clumsy and slowed us down. We would rather have had a bead (left) or low-mounted filament (right). Another option we would rather have was porting, either standard (left) or pigeon style by Pro Port (from magnaport.com). Porting offers better control for follow-up shots.

The importance of shotgun fit is immense. Perhaps the most valuable extra was the complete set of shims that mount between the stock and the receiver. These precise-fitting parts can effectively change the length of pull, cast, or pitch of the stock.
