The Springfield, which we bought for a counter price of \$849, has a lot going for it. The barrel was superbly fitted by any standard. The adjustable sights are excellent examples of the breed. Accuracy and handling cannot be faulted.



Recoil is there with a 45-caliber pistol, but the Range Officer was pleasant to fire.



Female shooters tend to like the shorter grip and thin frame of the 1911. But women with longer fingers will like the Glock.



Perhaps the best feature of the Range Officer was the steel adjustable rear sight. The Glock's polymer rear adjustable was better than a driftable rear.
